



Maths Fractions

Recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Position and direction

This unit focuses on describing position in relation to other objects, describing lateral and rotational movement and describing and completing repeating patterns. Children will apply their previous learning about fractions to describe degrees of turn and their knowledge of 2D shapes. This unit also helps children to develop their logical and computational thinking in order to follow and describe sequences relating to movement.

Geography

In Geography we are learning about Jamaica. We will be exploring maps of the world, locating where we live and how far Jamaica is from our country. We will be comparing our weather patterns to that of Jamaica. We will also explore how Jamaican houses are different to ours.

Curriculum Enrichment

English

In English, the children will be exploring the story Granddad's Island. We will be writing our own return narrative, focusing on sentence structure and using expanded noun phrases. Later in the term, we will be writing a non-chronological report on jungle animals.

Science

In Science, the children will be 'Going on Safari' and exploring what an invertebrate is. We will be observing and identifying different invertebrates around our school grounds; thinking carefully about how to care and look after them.

RE and PSHE

In RE, we will be exploring the question 'Are Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur important to Jewish children?' We will be learning about the festivals Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur and why they are important to Jewish people.

In PSHE, we will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy; considering our personal hygiene, thinking about sleep, staying hydrated and the importance dental health.

Computing and PE

In computing this term, we are focusing on our sound recording skills. We will have the chance to explore how to create our own music recordings and layering rhythms using the Scratch Jr App and Garage Band.

PE, the children will be practicing their ball skills. They will learn how to catch a ball dropped from shoulder height.

Wow Week

In DT we will be focusing on our textiles and embroidery skills. We will learn the basics, like threading a needle and how to use a running stitch to join fabrics together.

In Music, the children will be continuing their learning about Reggae music. They will learn the lyrics and perform various reggae songs. They will also have the chance to turn a famous song by George Ezra into a reggae style.
