To use paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme

Proof read for spelling and punctuation errors

Choose nouns or pronouns appropriately for clarity or cohesion and to avoid repetition

Select appropriate vocabulary to add interest and clarity

Use commas to separate items in a list and apostrophes to mark when a letter is missing and plural and singular possession.

Use familiar punctuation correctly (capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark, inverted commas)

Know and use some of the grammar terminology when discussing their writing e.g determiner, pronoun, possessive pronoun, adverbial

To write with consistent use of verb forms

Use correct speech punctuation for direct speech.

Increase legibility, consistency and quality of handwriting

Use further suffixes and prefixes and understand how to add them

Spell homophones and words that are often misspelt

Be able to write dictated sentences which include most year 3 and 4 spellings
