



Maths

This term, the children will be learning how to add and subtract using the column method.

- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including: a 2-digit number and ones.
- Solve problems with addition and subtraction: using concrete objects and pictorial representations, including those involving numbers, quantities and measures.
- children will progress to addition and subtraction involving two 2-digit numbers, again representing the steps within these calculations visually with different resources.
- Children will use the column method as a way to represent the mental calculation steps, but not see this as the only method for calculation.

History

In History, we will be learning about Mary Seacole and her exciting life where she travelled many different countries nursing wounded soldiers.

Curriculum enrichment

History-

Visit Kettering library and research Mary Seacole.

Visit Northampton Art gallery to take part in a creative workshop.

English

In English, we will be continuing our work on using adjectives to describe and we will be learning to write a setting description linked to the seasons.

We will continue to practice using full stops and capital letters in our sentences. We will also be using coordinating conjunctions to join ideas in a sentence.

Science
